5. Once the business rescue plan is approved, the BRP has agreed to extend the mandate of the Committee such that the BRP may also consult with creditors through the Committee on the implementation thereof.
6. The Committee will be entitled to receive and consider all notices and reports relating to the business rescue proceedings on behalf of the general body of creditors.
